With the help of a then final year resident, Anita .S, this taxing labour spanned almost 6 months (late 2006 to early 2007) and now the end result stands proudly in the institute – an invaluable asset to our alma mater, and has become legendary country wide.

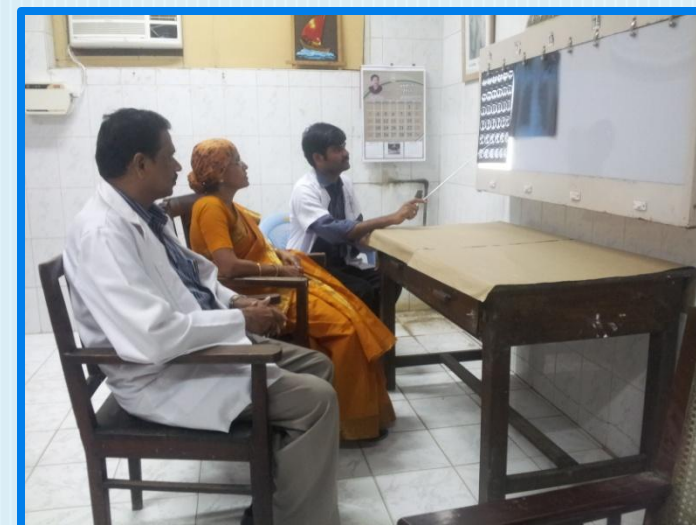

Greetings to you all.

Following the success of the previous BIR PG Primer courses, we are pleased to announce the 7th BIR PG PRIMER COURSE from 7th to 9th, February 2014 at Barnard Institute of Radiology, Madras Medical College, Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital .

The teaching course has been designed as a three day intensive coaching program, to build on basic knowledge in order to assist **final year radiology postgraduate candidates preparing for their final examination.**

The course concentrates on clinical applications, systematic approach to image interpretations and pitfalls.

The program consists of special focus sessions, film reading sessions and small tutorial groups (maximum 10 delegates per group).

This provides an opportunity for each student to participate in image interpretation under expert guidance, and ensures two way communication. Sessions are designed to conform as closely as possible to the examination format. Spotters and system wise case discussions will be covered in separate days. There will be continuing feedback assessment throughout the course and a final assessment.

This 3 day premier course is highly recommended for all radiology trainees as the emphasis is on small group tutorials instead of lectures. This is the first of its kind in India.
